



Sustainability Policy Statement

GPS Marine Contractors Ltd recognises that its activities, products and services have the potential to have both positive and negative impacts on society, the environment and the economy. Our activities include: dredging, marine construction, river and light towage and their associated business administration.

Top management endorses this policy and ensures it is compatible with the context and strategic direction of the Company. Top management in co-ordination with the Department Managers are accountable for the effectiveness of this policy and are responsible for ensuring that it is communicated, understood, implemented and maintained at all levels within the Company and ultimately, that it achieves its intended outcomes.

Top management has established the following to help deliver on the Company's vision:

- **Develop and implement a 'net zero' emissions strategy.**

 - **Eliminate all emissions from vessels and reduce toxic air pollution by replacing the existing tug fleet with a hydrogen fuel cell alternative from 2040.**

- Ensure that commercial decisions are focused on the long-term.
- Protect the environment, including the prevention of pollution and prudent use of natural resources.
- Reduce impacts associated with energy use by actively and responsibly managing energy consumption.
- Implement responsible labour practices and respect human rights.
- Ensure we do not engage in restrictive trade practices or other forms of anti-competitive behaviour.
- Fulfil our legislative and compliance obligations using established management systems, operating procedures, risk assessments and competent employees.

- Be open with our interested parties about our decisions and activities that we know will have, or are likely to have, a significant health, safety, environmental, quality or sustainability impact.
